Instructions: New England Law | Boston

With approval from a student's current law school, New England Law | Boston may accept applicants for nonmatriculating visit-in status, based on space availability.

Application deadlines for nonmatriculating visit-in students:

Fall semester: July 1

Spring semester: November 1

Application Requirements

If applying for nonmatriculating visit-in status, you must complete the following steps:

- 1. Submit a completed New England Law application form.
- 2. Submit the \$65 application fee in accordance with the above deadlines.
- 3. Send the following documentation:
- A letter of good standing from your current law school granting permission to visit-in, which states any conditions regarding grades, courses, and minimum/maximum credits that will be transferable
- One recommendation from a law professor
- An official transcript from your current law school
- A short personal statement
